#### Schools League Competitors

To compete in the School's League senior school competitors **MUST** be registered before the event. School groups should be pre-entered using the special form described above. Individuals wishing to compete in the league and additional School Group Members may register on the day. On registering, each person will be allocated a school member ID number and membership card. This number must be remembered as it will be required to complete the on the day entry form at all school league events. This will ensure smooth progress at download. Competitors wishing to register for the league on the day should obtain a school member ID number from E-card hire before entering for the event.

If all pre-printed maps are used, maps will be recycled. In this case please be prepared to give up your map at the finish. If you want a copy of your map please leave your name and details at registration.
