For anyone interested, I updated the map in OpenStreetMap, then created a pdf map in "pseud-O" format using OpenOrienteeringMap. Control placement was done using Purple Pen as this will accept a map in pdf format. This means all elements used were freeware, requiring no licenced software. For Routegadget I "printed" the course from Purple Pen to pdf, then used one of several free online converters to transfer this to gif format.
