

## New 2020: DEEside Orienteering League

The aims are to:

- encourage participation and competition throughout the year
- encourage members to experience different orienteering formats and venture beyond the boundaries of DEEland to adjacent club areas.

There will be 12 events each year. A competitor's overall score will be the sum of his/her best 6 event scores.

The Open Category is open to all DEE members competing on the Green to Black courses (including Very Short & Short Green, Short Blue and Short Brown where offered).

The Junior Category is open to all junior DEE members competing on White to Light Green courses (technical difficulty 1-4).

There are eight Junior Categories: JM1 & JW1 (under 10, White course), JM2 & JW2 (M/W10, Yellow course), JM3 and JW3 (M/W12, Orange course), JM4 and JW4 (M/W14, Light Green course).

The scoring for the Open Category will be based on the MDOC system [based on the competitor's pace (time/distance) adjusted for category and course length]. More information at [www.mdoc.org.uk/2019-club-championship](http://www.mdoc.org.uk/2019-club-championship)

Scoring for the Junior Categories will be as for the UK Orienteering League system (1st place 50 points, 2nd place 49 points, etc).
